



1 - Pull the 2 latches at the same time and put the wheel board in place with the help of the 2 spigots on cabinet.



ASSEMBLY :


TOOLS : Allen Key 6mm , Torx n°40.

- 1 - Remove Handle.
- 2 - Remove the 6 threaded Plug.
- 3 - Fill each screw hole with Loctite 243 TM or equivalent.
- 4 - Insert rubberised Spacer between Rigging plate and cabinet (Painted version only).
- 5 - Tighten the 6 rigging plate screws alternately, at the rate of 4 revolutions each time.
- 6 - Insert rubberised Spacer between handle and cabinet (Painted version only).
- 7 - Reinstall Handle.



1. Dismount the rubber pad.
2. Insert the metal corner.
3. Put the rubber back and tight.
4. Repeat the steps for the others.



1. Place the first RS18 on the Dolly.
2. Push down-wards the mobile part of the rigging system right until it is on the Dolly.
3. Remove 1 of the 2 Quick Release pins from its parking position and insert it into the Dolly.
4. Secure all the RS18s by inter-locking themselves.
