




Recommended Installation


Fans mounted inside the Wall-Mount cabinet draw air out of the cabinet to provide proper equipment cooling.






2 Mount the shroud casing over the fans using the supplied hardware.





Alternative Installation


Fans mounted outside the Wall-Mount cabinet draw air out of the cabinet for proper equipment cooling.




For external installation, begin by installing the fan into the shroud using the supplied hardware.



Mount the assembly over the vents on the exterior of the Wall-Mount cabinet, threading the screws from the inside of the cabinet.



3 Secure the wire between each fan to the cabinet using the peel-and-stick cable anchor with tie.



Plug the SRFANWM input cable into a power source, such as an external source. For connection to an internal PDU, utilize the removable cable access panel.
