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WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Please register online: <u>http://www.elationlighting.com/Login.aspx</u> to validate your purchase. All returned service items whether under warranty or not, must be freight pre-paid and accompany a return authorization (R.A.) number. The R.A. number must be clearly written on the outside of the return package. A brief description of the problem as well as the R.A. number must also be written down on a piece of paper and included in the shipping container. If the unit is under warranty, you must provide a copy of your proof of purchase invoice. Items returned without a R.A. number clearly marked on the outside of the package will be refused and returned at customer's expense. You may obtain a R.A. number by contacting customer support.

IMPORTANT NOTICE!

There are no user serviceable parts inside this unit. Do not attempt any repairs yourself; doing so will void your manufactures warranty. Damages resulting from modifications to this fixture and/or the disregard of safety and general user instructions found in this user manual void the manufactures warranty and are not subject to any warranty claims and/or repairs.

LIMITED WARRANTY

A. Elation Professional® hereby warrants, to the original purchaser, Elation Professional® products to be free of manufacturing defects in material and workmanship for a period of two years (730 days), and Elation Professional® product rechargeable batteries to be free of manufacturing defects in material and workmanship for a period of six months (180 days), from the original date of purchase. This warranty excludes discharge lamps and all product accessories. This warranty shall be valid only if the product is purchased within the United States of America, including possessions and territories. It is the owner's responsibility to establish the date and place of purchase by acceptable evidence, at the time service is sought.

B. For warranty service, send the product only to the Elation Professional® factory. All shipping charges must be pre-paid. If the requested repairs or service (including parts replacement) are within the terms of this warranty, Elation Professional® will pay return shipping charges only to a designated point within the United States. If any product is sent, it must be shipped in its original package and packaging material. No accessories should be shipped with the product. If any accessories are shipped with the product, Elation Professional® shall have no liability what so ever for loss and/or or damage to any such accessories, nor for the safe return thereof.

C. OVERVIEW



- 1. 5 Wire (V+, Red, Green, Blue, White) 12-14 AWG Terminal Blocks
- 2. DMX INPUT / 3pin XLR
- 3. DMX OUTPUT / 3pin XLR
- 4. DMX Address / Manual Mode DIP Switches
- 5. Manual Voltage Select Switch (on back side)

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INSTALLATION

- **1**. Mount driver on a flat surface with appropriate screws (not included).
- 2. Select desired voltage by adjusting Voltage Select switch on backside.
- 3. Turn ON desired DMX Address / Manual Mode DIP Switches. (See next sections)
- 4. Connect DMX IN/OUT cables.
- 5. Connect LEDs to terminal blocks and insert into corresponding channel ports.
- 6. Connect power cable to outlet.

DMX ADDRESSING



- 1. To set driver DMX address, select DMX ADDRESS Mode by turning ON switch #10.
- 2. Using the chart below, turn on the switches that equal the desired DMX address.
 For example to set a DMX address of 250, turn ON switches #2, #4, #5, #6, #7, #8.
 (2 + 8 + 16 + 32 + 64 + 128 = 250)

DIP SWITCH	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
VALUE	1	2	4	8	16	32	64	128	256

STAND ALONE MODE



- 1. To control LEDs manually, set driver to **STAND ALONE Mode** by turning OFF switch **#10**.
- Using chart below, turn ON switches that equal desired control for each function:
 Fade Time, Speed, Program, and Mode.

For example to select AUTO Program, turn ON switches **#7, #8,** and **#9**.
