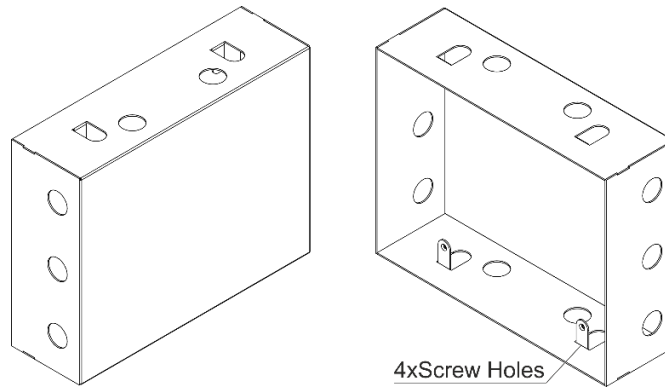

Step 1: Check what's in the box

- ✓ 4 M3x8 screws with washers

Step 2: Get to know your KT-107-INWB

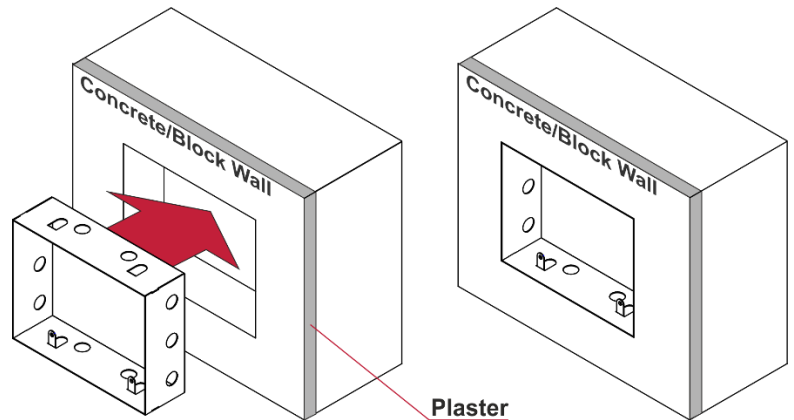
KT-107-INWB is used for installing a touch panel in a concrete wall.



Step 3: Install the KT-107-INWB

For concrete or block wall surfaces:

- i** Use the Kramer **KT-107-INWB** In-Wall Box for KT-107 Touch Panel for concrete installations.
 1. Make sure that the prepared opening in the concrete fits the dimensions of the in-wall junction box.
 2. Insert the **KT-107-INWB** into the opening.
 3. Carry out Touch Panel installation instructions as described in **KT-107-INWL** Quick Start: www.kramerav.com/downloads/KT-107-INWL
- i** Make sure to place the **KT-107-INWB** flush with the plaster surface.
