## Connecting to the Amplifier

1. Connect the SPEAKER OUT jack of the amp to the INPUT jack on the back on this cabinet.



- Only use speaker cable to connect the speaker. Do not use any shielded cable designed for use with guitars.
- \* To prevent malfunction and equipment failure, always turn down the volume, and turn off all the units before making any connections.

### Converting the Cabinet to an Open Back

When the unit is shipped from the factory, the cabinet has a closed back. By removing the board from the middle of the back, you can convert the cabinet to an open back.

Loosen eight screws and remove the board.



\* Do not remove anything other than the middle board.
