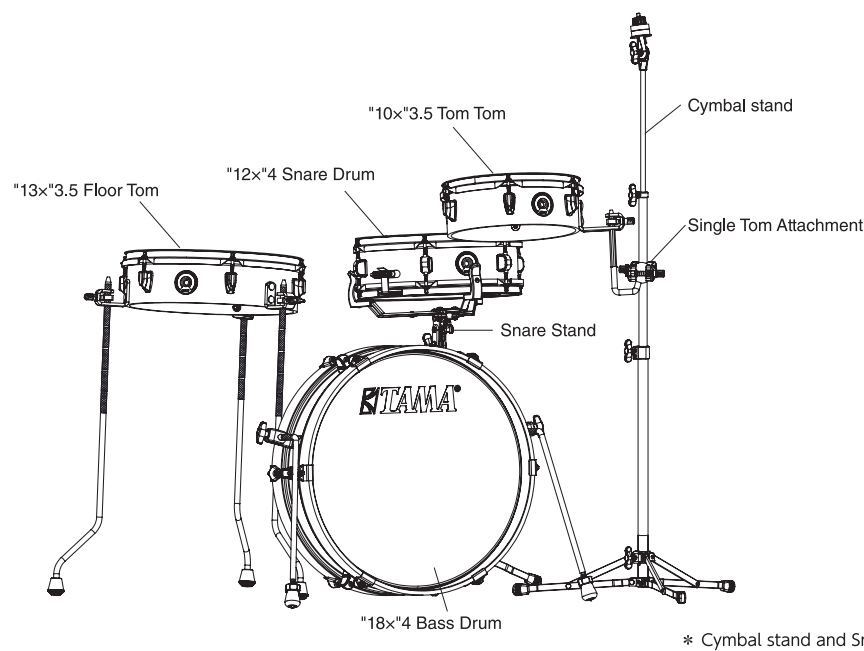


Club-JAM Pancake

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Thank you for your purchase of the Club-JAM Pancake. To ensure the safe and efficient use of this product, please read through this manual before use. Store this manual in a convenient place for future reference.



Assemble

Bass Drum

As shown in Fig. 1, from the bass drum's front side, pass the bass drum spur through the leg bracket and tighten the T-nut to secure it in place. A rubber tip or spike can be used at tip of the spur. The spike can be used when the drums are placed on a carpet or rug, and the rubber tip when the drums are placed on a hard surface. The rubber tip's position can be secured by tightening the locknut.

IMPORTANT

When using the spike tip, the floor underneath the carpet or rug may still become damaged. If the floor should not be damaged, use the rubber tip and make sure the spike does not extend past the rubber tip.

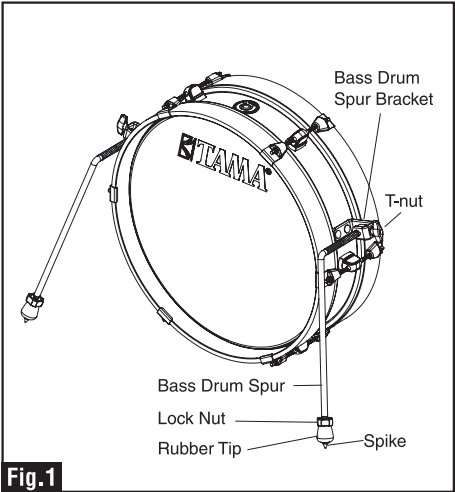

Floor Tom

As shown in Fig. 2, four tom legs are included: three of the same length and one shorter.

Place the floor tom on the ground, drumhead side down, then pass the three floor tom leg rod of the same length through each bracket (as shown in Fig. 3). Then, tighten each T-nut to secure them in place.

If the floor tom is set too low on the leg, the tip of the leg may rest above the hoop (as shown in Fig. 4). If this happens, replace the floor tom leg nearest the player with the shorter one (as shown in Fig. 5).

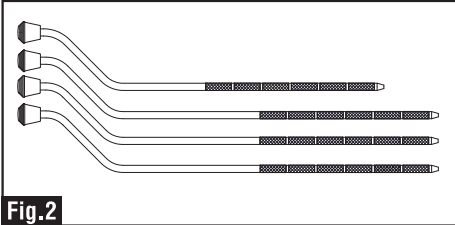

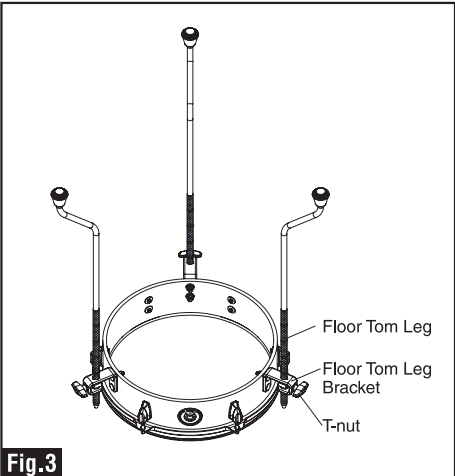

Storage

1. Using cushion A in Photo 1, wrap the tom tom and set it inside the floor tom (as shown in Photo 2). Store the nested drums in the small bag as shown in Photo 3.
2. As shown in Photo 4, place cushion B in Photo 1 on top of the floor tom, then set the snare on the cushion and close zip the bag closed.
3. Remove the spurs from the bass drum and store it in the large bag (as shown in Photo 5).
4. Place the small bag on top of the bass drum and zip the bag closed (as shown in Photo 6).

IMPORTANT

Take extra care when transporting and carrying the drum kit in the bag. If handled roughly, the drum shells or shell hardware parts may become damaged.
*Please note that if you carry or store the drum kit without using TAMA's specially made bag, the inside of the bass drum shell and the drumheads may be scratched or damaged.

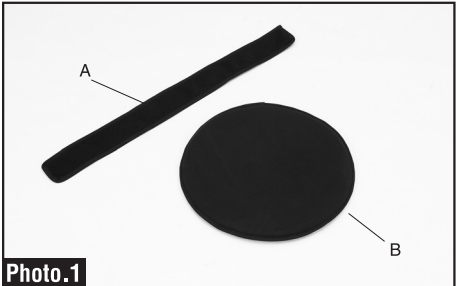
